### Some Solo & Ensemble guidelines:

- Participation form (with payment) is due **Wednesday, November 1, 2017**.
- **DON'T PROCRASTINATE!!!** If your event needs an accompanist, take care of it today! If you are performing in a duet, trio, quartet, quintet, sextet, etc., pick your music immediately and don't wait until mid-January to start rehearsing together. Save yourself the headache and start now!
- If your event also includes a piano accompaniment, the piano accompaniment **MUST** be played. No accompaniment = no rating. Secure an accompanist and get them your piano music **IMMEDIATELY...** do not wait! If you need an accompanist:

- **Your event must be at least two minutes in length to receive a rating.** Events under two minutes in length will receive comments only. Please time your piece well in advance and choose your piece accordingly!
- **All events MUST have an original score (all the parts together, not individually) with the measures numbered to be given to the adjudicator.** Xerox copies of scores for the judge are not acceptable.  
**No score = no rating.**
- If Public Domain or purchased online copies of music are used, proof of where you obtained the music from is required.
- You must play classical music... pop music is not acceptable for an event like this.
- A schedule with maps and other detailed information will be distributed when information is received from MSBOA (usually the week before festival).
- It is expected that solo & ensemble events will be rehearsed/prepared independently, outside of class time. However, each event needs to meet/rehearse with Mr. Takis or Mr. Gross before or after school prior to the festival date. Additional rehearsal time may be scheduled at the student's request.
