1. Call to Order/Approval of Agenda- Noah Resnick

2. Secretary’s Report/Approval of Minutes - Sara Martin
Sara’s Report was read by Holly-

The board discussed issuing trip credits to Corporate Travel in time for the January 9th payment for Nashville. Dean will plan to issue trip credits by December 15th. Families will be notified of the totals in order to subtract them from their balance.
3. Band/Orchestra Opening Comments - Chris Takis, Montana Crawford
Chris and Montana were not in attendance. Montana’s report was read by Libby.
She said that Adam Riccinto is coming as a clinician for the full orchestra on October 23rd. He is the conductor Ypsilanti Symphony Orchestra. The orchestra classes have been working hard on their Pops and Pastries pieces.
4. Treasurer’s Report - Dean Zoyes
 - A. QuickBooks Online File
Information was uploaded into the nonprofit QuickBooks online. All files have been converted over.
 - B. Pops & Pastries Financial Tracking
Once we have ad sales finalized for Pops and Pastries, they will be added to Monday and trip credits will be added.
 - C. Trip Credit Calculator
Ad sales will be added into the trip credit document once finalized. Mattress credits have been added.
5. Vice President’s Report - Adam Wieczorek

We need to email the parents with student trip credit totals before the registration deadline for Nashville, as that may impact their decision to travel.

6. Committee Reports:

A. Communications/Website - Libby Robinson

Libby wants to post ticket sales this week. The prices are - \$5 student/child, \$20 advance, \$25 at the door, and 8 top table for \$300, and a 4 top for \$175. The website pricing is not correct for individual sales (listed as \$25 in advance). Dean will look into fixing the issue.

Libby got a few more auction items- Zealous Root, Med Spa, Detroit Public Theater. We need to decide which are tin can items vs. silent auction items.

B. Bylaws Sub Committee — Dean Zoyes

The Bylaw subcommittee had a meeting. Adam, Noah, Dean, and Jessica were in attendance. The bylaw suggestions will be presented to the board at a later date. Some items will fall under standard operating procedures rather than bylaws. The GPPSS will pay the legal fees to Clark Hill to update our bylaws.

C. Fundraising Update - Kellie Wieczorek, Holly Bayster

1. Mattress sale update- \$4340 in trip credits were earned and the boosters earned an additional \$1000 for the general fund. There was a discussion about students soliciting sales at the door. Dean wondered if a Sign Up Genius in 1 hour increments would be a good idea for next year.
2. Kellie and Holly continue to solicit and receive donations for Pops and Pastries. We would like to focus on a handful of restaurant gift card donations.
3. Charity gaming update? Do we want to continue to look into this?
4. Libby mentioned that choir does a very successful raffle, where students are asked to sell a set number of tickets. This month, they made \$12,000 profit.
